

Fairy Tale/Folk Tale Paper Bag Book Report Directions

Due: October 9, 2009

1. The **front** of your paper bag will represent a **cover**. Using a blank piece of paper, **draw a colorful scene** from the book. Attach this to your paper bag when you are finished. Make sure the front of your bag includes:
 - a. The **title** of the book
 - b. The **author**
 - c. **Your name**
2. On the back of the bag attach the worksheets where you identified the:
 - a. **Main Characters**-Include all of the main characters
 - b. **Supporting Characters**-Include any other characters that may have been in the story but were not main characters.
 - c. **Setting**-Include the places and the time periods your story took place.
 - d. **Conflicts**-Include the main problem within the story.
 - e. **Summary** of the beginning and the middle of the story.
 - f. **Conclusion**: the ending of the story.
3. Inside the bag place **at least four objects** that represent **significant events** that happened in the book. You **could** also place objects that show **aspects of the main characters' personalities**.
4. You will be asked to **tell the class about your book and how your items relate to the story**. You may use notes as long as you it does not interfere with your ability to speak to the audience. You will be given points for how clearly you speak and for your ability to explain how each item relates to your story.

Example: Front of the Bag

Example: Back of the Bag (worksheet)

Main Characters: Red Riding Hood, The Wolf

Setting: The story takes place in the woods and Grandma's house. I think it was set in the past because the mom did not call the grandma after sending Red Riding Hood to see her. This was a clue telling me there are no phones.

Conflict: The main problem in the story was Red Riding Hood was given very specific direction by her mother and she did not follow them. This leads to the next problem in the story which was the wolf eating Red and her grandma.

Summary of the beginning and the middle of the story:
