

Send a song to iTunes

You can send a song to iTunes and play it in iTunes, add it to playlists, download it to an iPod, or burn it to a CD. Songs are sent to iTunes in AIFF format. You can convert the exported file to another format, such as AAC (m4a) or MP3, from within iTunes.

To send a song to iTunes:

1. Choose Share > “Send Song to iTunes.”
2. In the Share dialog, select the Compress checkbox, then choose compression settings from the Compress Using and Audio Settings pop-up menus.

You can also change the playlist, artist, album, and composer information.
3. Click Share.

When you send a song to iTunes, it appears in the iTunes library, where you can add it to playlists, convert it, or burn it to a CD.

The entire song, from the beginning to the end of the last region, is exported. If the cycle region is turned on when you export the song, the part of the timeline from the start to the end of the cycle region is exported.

If a project has a podcast track, the command “Send Podcast to iTunes” appears in the Share menu. If the project has a movie track, the command “Send Movie to iTunes” appears in the Share menu. Choosing either of these commands exports the entire project, regardless of whether the cycle region is turned on or off.
